

The Brick Farmhouse School: Preschool

Sample Daily Schedule

8:00-8:15 Students arrive.

Personal belongings are put away and morning greetings are shared. Students head to their spot on the carpet and complete their “morning work”. This work will be set at the student’s level and reflect previous daily work.

8:15-8:30 Morning meeting.

During this time, we will meet with the K-5 students and say the pledge of allegiance, listen to the daily devotional, morning message, the sharing of stories and overview of our daily educational tasks.

8:30-8:45 Circle time.

During this time, PreK through Kindergarten students will gather. Circle time includes a name song, calendar time, a counting activity, days of the week song, and discussion of the weather.

8:45-9:05 Language focus.

Throughout the year, this will include working on letters (memorization, letter sounds and pronunciation), writing names, and sight words.

9:05-9:15 Bathroom break.

9:15-9:45 Center time #1 and cleanup.

“Centers” provide meaningful collaboration and imaginative play opportunities for the students. The students will rotate through each “center”. Social and positive behavioral skills are gained throughout the process.

Centers may include: Block Center, Dramatic Play Center, Sensory Center, Art Center, Library Center, Writing Center, Math Center and Science Center

9:45 –10:05 Math time.

Throughout the year, the focus will be on working with numbers, shapes, colors, and problem solving.

10:05- 10:20 Snack time.

10:20- 10:30 Story time.

A story will be read to the students, and discussion will be had about the book and the moral of the story, if applicable.

10:30-10:50 Monthly theme focus.

This includes relevant hands-on activities related to the monthly theme i.e. guest speakers, planting flowers, etc. Schedule of monthly themes will be included in the welcome packet.

10:50-11:25 Center time #2 and clean up.

Rotation through the centers will be continued during this time. Students will visit the centers that they were unable to get to within the first “center” time frame.

11:25-11:30 Students get packed up to go home.

****Please note that the Brick Farmhouse School preschool class will be outside, learning in nature as much as possible, as much as time and weather permit.*
